AT A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE CONGREGATION ON OCTOBER 16TH,

Good Shepherd voted unanimously to call Rev. Bill Davis as its next installed pastor. This came as a recommendation of the Discernment Team. At the last Presbytery meeting, Presbytery approved his call to be our installed pastor. Stay tuned for the date of the installation service as we celebrate the important change in relationship from temporary to installed pastor between Bill and the congregation.

CALLING ALL TURKEYS!! The Schools across the street (Vantage Point, Crossroads and Vista View) have between 30-40 families of students who cannot afford a Thanksgiving Dinner. The school staff prepares baskets for each of these families every year with all the fixings for a nice holiday meal, including a turkey for each one. Your Outreach Committee here at Good Shepherd has been in conversation with the school administration about how we can partner with them to support these families. The most needed item is the turkey for each basket. The staff and teachers pay out of their own pockets for all of the items for these baskets. In the past, grocery stores would help out a little but that just doesn't happen much anymore. So the Outreach Committee is asking for your help in our commitment to provide 20 turkeys for the Thanksgiving Baskets. If you can provide a 12 lb. turkey, please bring it to church with you on November 13th. If you would rather donate money for a turkey, that would be great as well and one of us will do the purchasing for you! Please mark your donation "school turkey" and place it in the offering plate or bring to the office no later than Friday, November 11. Thank you so much for your help in supporting this important partnership as we assist in providing a nice Thanksgiving to these families.

FROM THE MISSION WORKGROUP Thank you to the GSPC Youth Group who prepared & served dinner for Growing Home last Saturday evening! ---- The Final CROP Walk total was \$9,000.00 collected by the five churches (including Good Shepherd) who participated in the West Adams County CROP Walk on October 8th. Good Shepherd's Food Bank will be a recipient of a portion of the funds. --- The Global Witness Offering received during October totaled \$377.00.
