AT A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE CONGREGATION ON OCTOBER 16TH,

At the last Presbytery meeting, Presbytery approved his call to be our installed pastor. December 4th will be the Installation Service as we celebrate the important change in relationship from temporary to installed pastor between Bill and the congregation.
