THE OUTREACH COMMITTEE hosted a very successful "Welcome Back" luncheon for the teachers & staff of Vantage Point, Crossroads and Vista View schools on August 12th. Thank you to all who contributed food and to all who came to help us thank the teachers & staff for all that they do. We hope to do this again next year! Looking ahead, we are planning quarterly Community dinners with the first one (a spaghetti dinner) planned for October 26, 6:00 p.m. More details will be in the bulletins and Shepherds' Crook soon.

ITEMS NEEDED FOR THE FOOD BANK FOR AUGUST: toilet paper, bar soap, and mac & cheese. Please place items in the bench in the Narthex or bring to the Food Bank. During July the Food Bank gave out 185 orders to 146 households, serving 475 clients, including 184 children.

THE 2 CENTS A MEAL OFFERING ON AUGUST 7 was \$80.68. Half of the money collected each month goes to Presbyterian Hunger Program and the other half goes to our Food Bank. Thank you so much!

NEWS BRIEFS FROM THE PRESBYTERY OF DENVER: **The Committee on Ministry** is currently working with ten congregations as they plan or search for new leadership. **Westminster Church completed the Leadership Training** portion of its New Beginnings discernment process this month. The process is supported by the congregation, Presbytery and the Presbyterian Mission Agency. **Two major educational events will be offered this fall** to the Presbytery: the Annual Leadership Retreat, "Courageous Listening," at Highlands on November 11th and 12th; and the

“Mental Health First Aid” on November 17th. Plan now to be part of both of these outstanding opportunities. In addition, the Council has authorized several opportunities, this fall, for the Presbytery to **discuss the Grant Street Property**. Watch for times and places of those discussions. **The Presbytery Council approved a tithe of 10%** of shared mission support gifts in 2015 to be drawn from the operating budget. This act has enabled all mission entities to be given additional grants this year. **Thirteen inquirers and candidates** are part of the preparation process which is overseen by the Committee on Preparation for Ministry. In October, Ruling Elder Laura Lunsford of Genesis Church and the Rev. Stan Jewell, Presbytery Moderator, will serve as **delegates to the Presbytery of Zimbabwe**.
