**THE PRESBYTERY OF DENVER WILL WELCOME FALL DELEGATION FROM ZIMBABWE PRESBYTERY** September, October and November will see four delegates from Zimbabwe Presbytery visiting congregations, preaching and speaking in services of worship, experiencing the power of our mission, and deepening the partnership between our two presbyteries. Arriving in September will be Rev. Anna and Moven Banda who will begin their time with a Long Leave or sabbatical time. For several weeks they will renew their spirits and gain strength for ministry. In October they will be joined by two pastors, the Rev. Lydia Neshangwe, Zimbabwe Presbytery Stated Clerk, and the Rev. Everisto Musedza, convener of the Presbytery's Church and Society Committee. All four will be hosted by the Partnership of Zimbabwe and Denver Presbyteries Committee. We give thanks for their coming to be with us and pray for a time of true partnership.

- We need drivers with pick-up trucks to pick up food donations at Wal Mart on Monday mornings at 8:30 a.m. (specifically the Wal Mart Neighborhood store at 10755 Washington Street in Northglenn) Need to be able to lift 20-40 lb. boxes. - Need drivers with full-size pick-up trucks to go to Food Bank of the Rockies to pick up purchased food --- food is loaded onto your trucks on pallets. Typical load is 1500-1800 lbs. Time commitment: 2 hrs. (once per month)
