ITEMS NEEDED FOR THE FOOD BANK FOR NOVEMBER: Soups or chili and toilet paper. Please place items in the bench in the Narthex or bring to the Food Bank. During October the Food Bank gave out 123 orders to 98 households, serving 310 clients, including 113 children.

IN THE CHURCH WE WORK IN LOTS OF DIFFERENT WAYS. On Sundays in worship, the liturgy - what we say and do - is literally "the work of the people." Over the past 50 years we have done some great work as a church - serving our neighbors, deepening the faith of disciples of Jesus Christ, and sharing in a common mission with other Presbyterians. In the coming weeks you'll be invited to reflect on what has worked well for us in the past, and dream about how we might work together as a congregation in the future, as we consider shifting the way we structure the work we do as a congregation.
